NJOTA Policy Survey

NJOTA surveyed **8,043 current, active licensed OT**practitioners on 5 core legislative gaps found within the current OT Licensing Act and Regulations. Reaching **22%** of our targetted population.

OT COMPACT & CEU REQUIREMENT

83% of respondents supported the addition of CEU requirements. CEUs are required to be accepted into the National OT Compact.



REQUIREMENT OF JURISPRUDENCE

CEU



55% of respondents supported the addition of jurisprudence CEUs for every biannual renewal cycle and were in support of requiring a 2-hour CEU.

CLARIFICATION OF SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS VIA TELEHEALTH

80% of respondents supported further clarification of telehealth supervision requirements for OT students and OTAs.



CLARIFYING MENTAL HEALTH

DEFINITIONS

88% of respondents supported the addition of language to clarify further and support OT's role in mental health. The aim is to provide language in our statutes and regulations that support OTP's education and expertise as qualified mental health professionals within the NJ Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services.



STRENGTHENING ORTHOTICS DEFINITIONS

96% of respondents supported the addition of language that further strengthens our role within orthotic fabrication and management.
